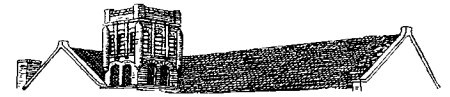

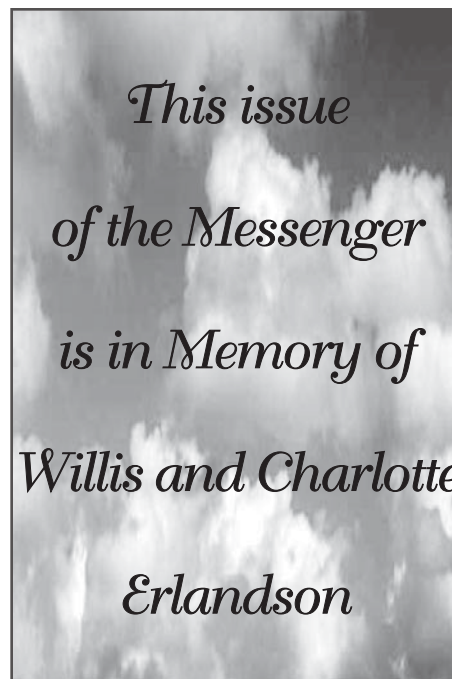
## Meals On Wheels



## The Work of Our Boards

The **Board of Elders** met on July 21 (after our August *Messenger* deadline). Following are highlights of that meeting.

- the baptism of Mason Wilke on August 6 was approved. It was also approved to accept the letter of transfer for Rev. Betsy Miller to the Edgeboro Moravian Church.
- Upcoming worship plans include the festival concert and worship service on July 23/24 and the outdoor worship service at Korth Park on September 4.
- Plans are well underway for our 2011-12 Sunday School season.
- Pastor Beth and Pastor Bruce mentioned the Holy Conversation to be held at Ebenezer on Sunday, September 25. It was also noted that the cross training conference will be at Mt. Morris from September 23-25.

The **Board of Elders** also met on August 18. Following are highlights of that meeting.

- Bruce will be attending the retreat at Mt. Morris on October 1 & 2. We will look for someone to supply the pulpit in his absence and will move communion to October 8 & 9 instead of October 1 & 2.
- Moravian Women's Sunday will be held the weekend of November 12 & 13 while Bruce is away and we will have our November communion on November 5 & 6.
- We need to update our pictures of board members for our "Getting to know you" board. Cindy Miller will take care of this.
- Wayne Staff and Cindy Miller agreed to be Elders reps on the New Consecration Sunday sub-committee.
- We talked with Rev. Jane Harberg about our church's retreat at Mt. Morris on September 30-October 2. She will take care of publicity and possibly do a Bible Study. Bruce will do short vespers on Saturday evening and a closing worship on Sunday morning.
- It was noted that we have lots of information from the time and talents sheets but that several folks did not fill out one of these sheets. We should make them available again this fall.
- Lay witness speakers were discussed.

The next regular Elders meeting will be held on September 15 and there will be a special Joint Board meeting with Jim Hicks on September 22.

The **Board of Trustees** met on Thursday, August 11. Following are highlights of that meeting.

- The treasurer's report was shared and approved. It was noted that our deficit through the end of July is less than half of what it was last year at this time. It was also noted that expenses through the end of July are down 7% from last year; while the offerings or collections are up 6% through July.
- A proposal for asbestos removal from the old offices before remodeling is in the works. Discussion was held concerning some bids for the old office remodel and what we would like to see in terms of the old office remodel. It also was decided to look at whether the air conditioning system that was in place in those offices still works. A sub-committee was formed to look at this.
- Repair of the mushroom lights by the lower parking lot is being looked at.
- Pastor Bruce gave a brief overview of Family Promise of Jefferson County. This will be discussed more in the future.
- It was decided to disconnect the land line at Pastor Beth's parsonage effective the end of September. At Pastor Bruce's suggestion it was decided to also disconnect the land line at that Fremont Street parsonage. Bruce will be available through cell phone. His cell phone number is (920)253-9030. ## Discipleship Conference

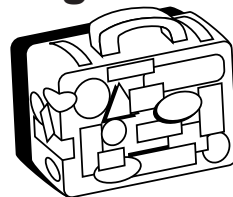
